The *Safety-Net Clinic Referral Directory* is a comprehensive inventory of the free and community health clinics in Milwaukee County that serve uninsured and underinsured patients.

The Milwaukee Health Care Partnership, in collaboration with the Milwaukee Free Clinic Collaborative and support from United Way of Greater Milwaukee, partnered with IMPACT Planning Council to collect this information on safety net clinic resources.

The 2014 inventory builds on the initial directories published in 2009 and updated in 2011 and 2013. The information collected is being released in two formats:

1. *The Safety-Net Clinic Referral Directory* can be used by health care providers, care managers and others working in helping professions to identify health care resources for underserved populations. The data is also made available to IMPACT 2-1-1, which serves as the complete information and referral source for Milwaukee County health and human services.
2. *The Safety-Net Clinic Planning Resource* can be used by community leaders, planners and funders to inform community health improvement strategy and investments.

Both the referral directory and the planning resource are available online at www.mkehcp.org and www.impactinc.org. Given the ever-changing health care environment, we recognize that the scope of services available through these clinics frequently changes. Therefore, we encourage users to routinely validate referral information directly with community clinic partners prior to making a referral and to rely on IMPACT 2-1-1 for the most up-to-date information about community health resources. Note on Survey Data

This *Referral Directory* provides up-to date information on community clinics providing services to under and uninsured patients in Milwaukee County. It includes information about medical, dental, family planning, STD/HIV clinics, and for the first time, agencies that provide clinical behavioral health services. Each clinic profile provides the location, hours of operation, languages, patient eligibility and payment practices in addition to clinical services and screenings.

All the information included in the *Safety Net Clinic Referral Directory* was provided by the responding clinics. Data gathering began with a letter sent to the identified clinics along with a pre-populated copy of the survey tool that was based on responses to the previous year's questionnaire. Clinics had the option to respond to the survey by mail, email, fax, over the phone, or through an in-person interview. Updated information was then entered into the database by staff from IMPACT Planning Council.

The data was verified by the clinics to confirm that information was correct. Clinic staff were contacted a minimum of three times with a request to review and approve their information. If a clinic provided information but did not respond to efforts to verify the data, that is noted on the clinic profile page.

Information was gathered from August 2013 through January 2014. In addition to being incorporated into this directory, it was also submitted to IMPACT 2-1-1 to update the online database. Clinics were encouraged to contact IMPACT 2-1-1 to assure that any changes in services or scheduling could be incorporated into the IMPACT data base.

In compiling the information for the directory, every effort was made to include information on each of the safety net clinics in Milwaukee County. In a project of this scope, omissions, missing data and human error may occur. Some clinics chose not to release certain information. A few clinics provided the information which is included in the companion *Planning Guide* but opted not to be included in this *Referral Directory*. 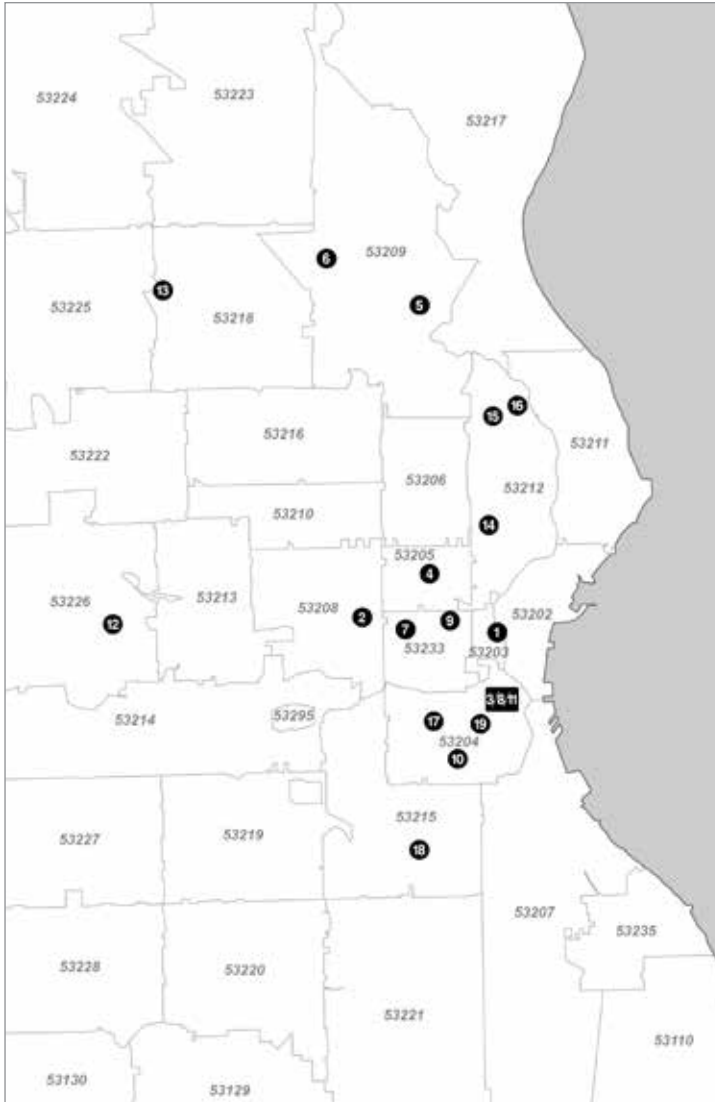

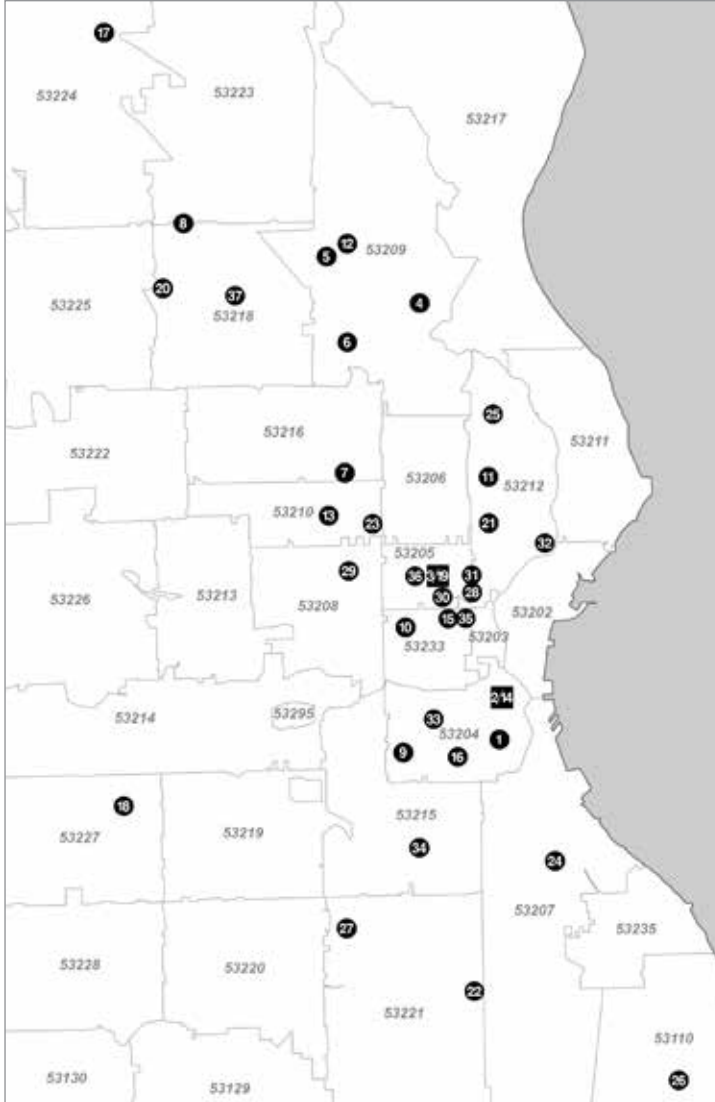
