

Medical Clinic Designation:

Free or Charitable Clinic indicates a clinic that provides care free of charge or on a sliding fee scale.

FQHC indicates a clinic that is a Federally Qualified Health Center.



A **Primary Care Medical Home** also known as a 'health home':

- is open > 30 hours / week
- maintains a health record for each patient
- maintains after-hours call coverage when the clinic is closed
- provides access to specialty medical care at the clinic or through formal referral relationships
- provides and manages medications



A **Dental Home**:

- is open > 30 hours / week
- maintains a dental record for each patient
- provides access to specialty dental care through formal referral relationships



The **Specialty Access for the Uninsured Program (SAUP)** provides specialty medical care for low-income and uninsured adults who are "established patients" at a participating clinic.

Participating SAUP clinics provide primary care, medication access, public benefits counseling, insurance enrollment assistance, and navigation and social supports. Each clinic is paired with a health system that provides a network of specialists for diagnostics, outpatient services and in-patient care. All usual and customary specialty consultation, testing and treatments are covered under SAUP, with no out-of-pocket cost to patients at or below 200% FPL and do not qualify for public insurance benefits.
