Available in person or over the phone, our Access Point team offers a pleasant and professional experience where clients feel supported, motivated and engaged.

Who is eligible for an Access Point assessment?

Milwaukee County residents age 18 years or older with a special emphasis on parents of minor children, pregnant women (no minimum age) and veterans. Insured and uninsured individuals are encouraged to inquire about options.

What should I expect from an Access Point assessment?

- The comprehensive assessment covers a range of considerations including mental health and trauma.
- Determinations are based solely on the needs of the individual.
- Clients may be assigned a Recovery Support Coordinator to help develop a care plan based on the client's needs and preferences.
- Clients may be connected to recovery support services to enhance their experience and improve their success.
